Mastic Beach, New York – To commemorate William Floyd’s importance to this nation and to the community of Shirley, Mastic, and the Moriches, the William Floyd School District commemorated his 277th birthday (December 17, 1734) with a series of in-school activities, lessons, and celebrations that culminated with a birthday celebration at the Mastic/Moriches/Shirley Library.

William Floyd was a New York State Senator, Major General, Delegate to the First Continental Congress, and founding father and signer of the Declaration of Independence.

William Floyd District Superintendent Dr. Paul Casciano said, “It is quite significant that our community produced a founding father and a signer of the Declaration of Independence.” The community agrees. Each year they actively participate in an annual celebration for the man for whom the William Floyd School District is named.
